CSC Orion .Why is the BNP advocating a British withdrawal from the European Union? Why does it want to turn Britain into the 51st state of America? Because, says Nick Griffin, "the whole purpose of the European Union has been to dismantle the nation state." This is a long-standing doctrine of the BNP and its forebears. The entire white nationalist movement for the past four decades has made this a core part of its ideology. In the US, some of our more prominent white nationalists, such as David Duke and the former KKK grand wizard, David Clarke, have over time held this belief. The US equivalent is the neo-Confederate movement. In the UK, on the far right, this has also been a widely accepted view. In the late 1980s, for example, the fascist National Front held Britain out of Europe as its prime reason for breaking with the rest of the EU. But the BNP is the first mainstream British party to come out in favour of a Brexit. Even the leader of the British Labour Party, Jeremy Corbyn, has not openly advocated a British exit from the EU. So why has the BNP changed its view? First, there is no party in the UK that is taking a more pro-European line. Many Tory Eurosceptics, such as the former chancellor of the exchequer, John Major, have long held this view. There are some on the more left of the Labour party, including Owen Jones, David Lammy, Jon Cruddas and Jon Ashworth. However, there is no position to be found within the Labour party that is calling for Britain to be in the
